State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James Wood Justice of Greenville District State afores^d for an Inconsideration of the best sum of three hundred and fifty Dollars, to me in hand paid by Dan^l Kelley of the District and State afores^d have bargained sold and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release, unto the said, Daniel Kelley all that tract parcel of land, lying North Side Beaverdam of Inners Porges Mountain, buting & bounding as follows, begining in middle of s^d beaverdam, joining Ensch Parsons land, thence to a post oak corner X; thence to post oak corner 2^d X; thence to stake Co. X^o; thence No. 1, to a Post oak Co. X; thence to a Post oak Co. X; thence No. 2, to a pine tree Co. X; thence No. 3, to pine Co. X; on land laid out for Pe^r Whorsten, thence So. 1, East on s^d Whorsten line to the middle s^d beaver dam, down the middle of the same, the begining, part being a grant originally granted to Ob. Cooper and part of a grant originally granted to El. Young the wife of George Salmon, including all within the above mentioned boundaries the same more or less, Together with all and singular the Rights, numbers, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the s^d premises blonging, or in any wise appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises, before mentioned unto s^d Daniel Kelley his heirs, Executors & administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the s^d Dan^l Kelley his heirs & assigns, against myself and my heirs and against, Every other person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, witness my hand & seal this 2^d day August in the year of our Lord 1803 - and in the 27th year of the Independence of the united States of America - a c.
