 Chain to three corners 3/4 thence N. 76<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> E. 51. Ch. to a post oak 3/4 thence  
 S. 82. W. 26. Ch. to a red Oak 3/4 thence S. 6. E. 42 Ch. & 50 links to the  
 Beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members  
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any  
 wise consistent or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the  
 premises before mentioned unto the said John Hinson his heirs & assigns  
 forever: and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators  
 to Warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the  
 John Hinson his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against every  
 Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same any part
