 less, To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Thos
 Edwards & his heirs forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to warrant
 & forever defend the above described land unto Thos. Edwards from me & my heirs
 & from every person or persons Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part

 south Eastward, and John W. E. Elkins Westwardly. It being part of a tract of Land
 that was granted to Gardiners Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments
 & appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise Incident or appurtenant
 To have and to hold all & singular the said premises before mentioned unto the
 said Ophias Hight Wood her heirs Executors & Administrators and I do hereby bind myself
 all & singular the said premises unto the said Ophias Hight Wood her heirs and assigns against
 myself and my heirs and against every person whatsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim
