

The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents, that I Isaac
 Cree of of Guenville District and in the said State, for and in Consideration of the sum of
 fifteen hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by John Blasingame, Have granted bargain sold
 & released and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell and Release unto the s^r John Blasingame
 his heirs and assigns. All that plantation tract or parcel of Land whereon I the said Isaac
 now live situate lying and being in the District aforesaid on the waters of reedy river, Containing
 five hundred and eighty Acre, be the same more or less, Being Originally granted in four
 different Grants, to wit, one Grant for one hundred acres granted to me the 6th day of March 1780
 one other Grant for one hundred and sixty acres granted to me the 7th day of August 1780 and
 other Grants for two hundred and forty four acres granted to me the 5th day of November 1792
 one other Grant for one hundred and thirty eight acres (part of which is thought to be an old survey)
 granted to Daniel Milbanks the first day of December 1794 & conveyed from the said Milbanks
 to me the 17th day of Jan^y. 1799. all which said parcels of Land are adjoining each other and
 are included in the following lines, To wit, Beginning on a Stake Corner running thence S 00^o
 W. 40^o to a Stake Oak, thence N. 25^o W. 40^o to a Stake Oak thence N. 30^o W. 40^o to a Stake thence
 N. 60^o E. 25^o to a Stake thence N. 75^o E. 50^o to a Stake thence S 26^o E. 66^o 50 to a Stake 37
 thence S 80^o E. 32^o to a Hickory thence with a natural line to the Beginning,
 corner, a draft of the hole being hereunto annexed, Together with all and singular
 the rights, members, & appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining To have and To hold all and singular the rights, members, tenements
 and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Premises, belonging or in any wise incident or apper-
 taining to the said John Blasingame his heirs and assigns forever - And I do hereby
 bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to Warrant and forever defend
 all and singular the said premises unto the said John Blasingame his heirs and
 assigns Against myself and my heirs and Against every other Person or Person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof -
