


State of S. Carolina } Personally came the within mentioned Rich<sup>d</sup> G

 mentioned James Couch & Mary Couch his wife sign seal acknowledge & Deliver the  
 Within and of conveyance unto the within mentioned James Nelson Cooke as there  
 and Deed for all the purposes therein mentioned & that at the same time he saw  
 Margaret Cooke & Susannah Cooke sign their names together with the said  
 subscribing Witnesses to the same, **SWORN** this 12<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of  
 our lord one thousand Eight hundred & four before me —  
 [Recorded the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1805.] Robert Cooke J. P.

I know all men by these presents that I William Cannon of the State of South  
 Carolina Greenville District HAVE bargained and sold unto Jonathan  
 one likely negro girl aged about ten months old named Chaima for & in  
 Consideration of the sum of twenty four Dollars Sterling to him in hand paid  
 well & truly paid by the said Jonathan Cannon before the dating and delivery  
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William  
 Cannon & himself fully satisfied & paid and I the said William Cannon as  
 being the lawful owner of the above bargained negro with warrants & force depud  
 the said negro to the only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Jonathan  
 Cannon & to his heirs & assigns forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set  
 my hand & seal 20<sup>th</sup> September 1804 —

Personally came before me Jonathan Potts & makes oath and says that he  
 saw William Cannon sign the within bill of sale for the purpose in mentioned  
 And that James Gilliland was a subscribing witness with himself at the  
 same time — **SWORN** to before me this 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1805
