This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & four. Between Robert Cox of the one part and W^m Cox of the other part both of the State of South Carolina & District of Greenville. Witnesseth that the S^r Robert Cox for & in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand well & truly paid at & before the signing & delivering of these presents I both bargained granted & sold, & by virtue of these presents both bargain Grant & sell unto the above S^r W^m Cox his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres more or less, lying & being situated in the State & District above s^d on the small branches of north Saluda & north of S^c Saluda. Being a part of a 500 acre tract Originally granted to George Johnson by his Excellency W^m Moultrie in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & twenty three & eighteenth year of our said Independence having such shape & marks as is represent by a plat therunto annexed Beginning at a chestnut oak near to Spriggs Spring branch & running by supposition on a north East course by the Rock Spring to a Gum running thence by supposition on a north East course on a direction to a stake on Williams line thence along Williams line in a northern direction to James Couches line thence along Couches line north West till it intersects with Spriggs line thence along Spriggs line by a south course to the Beginning Come to the above S^r W^m Cox his heirs & assigns To Have and To hold the above said land and premises with all woods and water houses & Gardens & Orchards & every thing in any wise therunto belonging from the S^r Robt Cox his heirs & assigns, and from all & every other person or persons from having a laying any just right title or claim therunto.
