tion of one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Archabal Cox of the other part
in the State & District aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents
do grant bargain sell & release all & singular that tract or parcel of land lying & being
in the State & District aforesaid on Spriggs branch waters of Chickadee River of Saluda
River including an improvement made by David Mash bounded by lines running
S. W. westerly by Williams, land that by Geo Salmon's land's. Beginning at a red o. 3 +
on Salmon's line & running thence a conditional line to a Hickory st from thence to a
Poplar & upon the branch thence to W. Cox line from thence to the out line of
the survey & then along the out line to the Beginning, being part of a survey of
500. acres granted to George Salmon in the year of our lord 1793. Containing one
thousand acres to the same more or less, Together with all & singular the rights man-
ners hereditaments & appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident to the said
premises, and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant
and forever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned to the R. A. Cox
his heirs & assigns forever against me & my heirs or against any other person or persons
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
