Have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & unto the said William Shelton a plantation or tract of land it being a part of a tract of lands that was originally granted to Richard Collins it being all that part that lies on the North side of Gilgors Creek - Beginning on a Gum Run s. 80. E. 30. Ch. to Spanish Oak as to include twenty acres of a tract conveyed by James Wafford to said Peck running S. 10. W. 46. Ch. to the said Creek beginning on a Chestnut then to include six acres down on the same side of said Creek so as to include the spring then up the various courses of said Creek to the Beginning black Gum including in the whole one thousand and twelve acres to the same more or less together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any wise Incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Wm Shelton & his heirs & assigns my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Wm Shelton his heirs & assigns forever. Against myself & my heirs & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Have granted bargained sold conveyed & confirmed and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Joseph Cobb his heirs or assigns a plantation or tract of lands containing Two hundred acres to the same more or less, being all that of a part of Three hundred acres of lands granted to Capt. Samuel Warren that lies on the South West side of Chicharow River of Saluda. Together with a part of a tract of land granted to Samuel Hand adjoining said warrens survey situated lying and being in the District aforesaid on the South West side of Chicharow River aforesaid - and runs as follows that is to say Beginning at a stake where said warrens line crosses said River thence S. 81 by two Degrees West to said Samuel Hand's corner on said warrens line thence with said Samuel Hand's
