



Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Brummitt of the state of South Carolina in a County of Greenville for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by William Carr of the state and County aforesaid & have granted bargained sold and released & by these presents do Grant bargain sell & Release unto the said William Carr a certain tract or parcel of lands containing fifty acres be the same more or less situated on the south side of the Middle fork of Saluda River. Beginning where the said Brummitts upper line crosses the River then across the River to the mouth of the second branch, thence up the said branch to the first hollow near an old field, thence to the said Brummitts upper line for compliments, it being a part of the lands the said Thos. Brummitt now lives on. Together with all & singular the rights members Incumbrances & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To Have & To Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Carr his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors or administrators to warrant & forever defend against all and singular the said premises unto the said William Carr his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs and against ever other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
