Ellkins now lives on and runs as follows Beginning on a tree Oak on the south side of south Tygar river Thence South fifty five degrees West Eight Chain to a post Oak Thence North Ninety degrees West nine chains to a maple on the edge of a lake Thence with said lake to the River including the Islands thence down the River to the Beginning - Containing eight acres be the same more or less - Together with all & singular Rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or pertaining - To have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Salmon his heirs and affigis forever - And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said George Salmon his heirs & affigis Against myself and my heirs and against all & every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - In witness whereof I have hereunto at my hand & sealed my seal the first day of May one thousand eight hundred and five - Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence of - Wm.
