 and assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators
 to warrant and ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Arow
 Minsey his heirs and assigns Against my self & my heirs & Against every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof —
