Know all men by these presents that I Lefe Goodlett have bargained & sold unto Charles Allen & Alex^r Waddell one Negro named Lucy one black horse saddle & Bridle three feather beds & furnished three bed sties & one Cotton Machine three tables one Shot Gun. also sum Kitchens furniture, to wit? pots one Oven one pan some plates knives & forks dishes & bowls tea & glass wares six chairs a cotton wheel two Axes one spade one crow bar two cows & calfs & one shovell one pair of scales & weights one pail and piggons. which said property I have sold & transferred to the said Charles Allen & Alex^r Waddell as a full satisfaction to them for what I owe them & to indemnify them for being security for me to John Robinson on a note & to Charles Maxwell for the purchase of a Negro on a note, which said property I do warrant & defend unto the said Charles Allen & Alex^r Waddell promise to deliver the same when called for.
