 one hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Elias Earle of the State & District
 aforesaid Have granted bargained & sold unto the above named Elias Earle
 all that tract or parcel of lands laying on Armstrongs Creek a branch of
 Saluda containing by computation one hundred acres. & including the place
 that Isaac Connor now lives on & known by the name of Davids upchurches old
 place. Beginning on the branch above the field on two white oaks a corner of
 a tract of lands sold by said Blackwell to said Earle & Shewen Earle in the
 presents of James Robertson & running down the branch to the creek & down
 said creek to a corner on the creek thence an east course near the course
 of the old path to a black gum in a small branch where a path crosses it
 thence down the branch to a white oak corner made by Ruben Martin below an
 old field thence a west course across the Ridge to the C^r to white oak
 thence a south west course to the back line to a stake thence a north course
 to the Beginning white oaks on the branch above the field

Together with all & singular the rights members here ditaments belong-
 ing or in any wise incident or appertaining unto the said Elias Earle
 his heirs & assigns forever. & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors
 Administrators & adm^{rs} to warrant and forever defend the above mentioned
