Arnolds all that plantation or tract of lands containing one hundred and eight acres lying in said District & State aforesaid, Beginning on a Stake corner 3^d on the Ancient Boundary running with said boundary line S. 35. 00 to a pine corner 3^d thence N. 81. 00. 18 to a post Oak 3^d thence N. 52. 00. 4. 50 to a post Oak 3^d thence S. 88. 00. 4. to a pine 3^d on D. George Martins lands thence N. 24. 50. to a post Oak on Joseph Thompsons lands thence W. 49. to red Oak 3^d thence N. 2. 50. to a stake 3^d thence E. 80. to a stake on W. Choices lands to the Beginning Stake corner, Together with all singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and To hold all singular the premises before mentioned unto the said W.B. Arnolds his heirs & assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to Warrant & defend all singular the premises to the said W.B. Arnolds his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
