The State of South Carolina Know all men by these Presents that I Josiah Cobb of the District of Greenville in the State aforesaid Farmer in consideration of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Noah Cobb of the District State aforesaid Blacksmith, Have Granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents Do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Noah Cobb all that part of a tract of Two hundred acres of Land, lying in the Dist. aforesaid on the waters of Mountain creek originally granted to Richards Brown, (deceased) By His Excellency William Moultrie on the fourth day of December 1786. Reference being thereto had will more fully appear all that part of said tract, Beginning on a red oak 3x8 Running N.W. 40^o 39' to a stake 3x thence S.W. 15^o 31' to a black oak 3x thence S.E. 10^o 15' to a stake 3x thence S.E. 78^o 24' - 55' to a stake 3x thence N.E. 20^o 23' to the Beginning containing one hundred and two acres. Together with all and singular the Rights members, Accretiments, and appurtenances to the said Premises Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and To Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Noah Cobb his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defende all and singular the said Premises unto the said Noah Cobb his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs & against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
