The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I James Kilgore of Greenville District in the State afores. for and in consideration of Three hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Nathaniel Walker of the State & District afores. I have Granted bargained & sold unto by these Presents both Grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Nathaniel Walker all that tract or parcels of Land containing Three hundred acres — it being a part of a tract of one Thousand acres originally Granted to Benjamin Kilgore Junr. on the thirde day of September in the Year 1792 and Recorded in Grant book for No. 5 Page 149. Situate in the State and District aforesaid betwix Rocky and Peter creeks waters of Snowe rivers. Beginning at a stake corner on the original line thence running on the said line S. 79. W. 39 ch. to stake corner on Isaac Hovers line, thence on said line N. 60 W. 14. 50 to stake corner made for John Mcshaffy thence on said line N. 5. W. 89. ch. to Pine corner thence N. 40. W. 87. ch. to red oak c. thence N. 18. W. 14 ch. red oak corner thence due East 20 ch. to stake c. on John Hitcheny line thence on said line S. 40. E. 12 ch. to red c. thence on a Hitcheny line N. 85. E. 8. 50 to Post oak c. thence due East on a marked line through said tract. 30. 50 to a gum corner thence S. 15. E. on marked line 58. 50 to a stake the Beginning c. — which includes the full Quantity of three hundred acres — Together with all and singular the rights members hereunto and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining — Thence unto and I the said James Kilgore do bind myself my heirs Executors and assigns to forever warrant and defend the above described Premises as aforesaid to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Nathaniel Walker his heirs Executors adm. and assigns against myself my heirs adm. & against every other person person or whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof — Witness my hands & seal this twenty ninth day of Oct. one thousand Eight hundred and five.
