 Pine Mountain, Beginning on said creek joining Enoch Bonsons land, thence to post oak
 C. + thence to post oak C. + thence to stake C. + thence N. 10. to post oak C. + thence to
 oak C. + thence N. 10. to pine C. + thence W. to land laid out Benjamin Whorton thence
 on said Whortons line S. twenty C. to said beverdam creek thence down the meanders of
