 of the State and District aforesaid for & in consideration of Five Dollars to me paid by William Chandler of the State and District aforesaid, the receipt is hereby acknowledged, Have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell & release unto the said William Chandler part of two tracts of land lying & being in Greenville District on mountain creek and water thereof one tract originally granted Wardsworth containing two hundred acres & by Wardsworth conveyed to s<sup>d</sup> Whorton & being the same land whereon s<sup>d</sup> Whorton formerly held the tract originally granted to James Holcoms by His Excellency Peter Broun & his joining the other tract on the north east side this containing one hundred & sixty acres both tracts containing three hundred & sixty acres be the same more or less bounded on the East side by Robert M. Apfee's land on the west by said William Chandler's land and on the north and north east by lands belonging to Anthony Griffin and Martin Ayres, with all & singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises belonging. To have & To hold all & every right & title to the said land before mentioned to the said William Chandler his heirs & assigns forever, and the said William Whorton doth warrant and defend the said land from himself and his heirs and from all and every other Person lawfully claiming the same to the said William Chandler his heirs & assigns forever.
