 to a certain tract of land purchased by the said James Harrison from John
 Wickley Esq. lying in Greenville District on Cripple Creek Waters of Needy River bounds
 South East by James Alexanders land N. & West by Aquilla Brasury & James
 Harrisons lands, & I do hereby bind & relinquish to the said James Harrison all my right title
 and Interest to the said tract of land, by any way whatever, either by virtue of any
 Judgment or Execution that I may have against the said John Wickley or any other
 claim whatsoever & further if it is found necessary at any time hereafter to sell the said
 land by Execution to obtain a title thereto in that case, I do hereby authorize the
 Sheriff of Greenville District to convey the said land to him the said James Har-
 rison or any ^{other} person or persons he the said James Harrison shall direct. & I do
 hereby engage to deduct the net proceeds of sales so made from the amt. of my Judg-
 =ment against the said John Wickley which is the oldest unsatisfied on Record
 Intestimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day & year above

 of the State of Georgia and Elbert County for & in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and
 fifty dollars paid to me by John Harrison of the State of South Carolina & District of Greenville
 Have Granted bargained sold Released and by these presents do Grant do Grant bargain
 sell and Release unto him the said John H. Harrison his heirs or assigns forever, all that part
 of a certain tract of of land Originally granted to Peter Meeks & signed by His Excellen-
 =cy William Moultrie on the 4th day of August 1786. for 470 acres. lying in the said district
 of Greenville on a branch of Mountain Creek waters of Saluda River, conveyed to the said
 Brown, by Meeks, on the 10th day of March 1793: all that part of the said tract of land
 Beginning on a black Oak the original corner, thence N. W. 70. 35 ch. to a post oak or thence N. W.
 15. 5 ch. to a stake Dudleys corner, thence N. E. 60. on Dudleys line to the corner, a stake thence on the
 said Dudleys line running Eastward as far as will include two hundred and fifty acres being
 marked by a line of trees to the original line be the same more or less, & being as in the actual
