Have Granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do bargain sell & Release unto the said Reubin Masten a certain tract or parcel of land containing four hundred acres be the same more or less. Situated in the State and district aforesaid including Armstrongs creek about one mile. it being a part of four tracts of land one originally Granted to William Masten one Granted to Nicholas Darnall one to Thomas Young one to Abdiash Hooper. Beginning on a post oak on W^m Southern line thence said line to Sutherly Spring branch thence said line to the next branch thence down said branch to a white oak thence a conditional line between said Masten and Elias Earl to a red oak on the bank of Armstrongs creek thence the conditional line to a red oak near the old ridge road thence to a stake in Thomas Youngs line thence the Original line to a white oak corner, thence Nicholas Darnalls line to the creek thence up said creek to a conditional line made between said Darnall & Abraham Bradley thence said line to a conditional line between said Blackwell & James Timley thence said line to the road thence to the Beginning - Together with all and singular the rights, members, covenants and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining.
