Together with all and singular the rights, members Hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining - To Have and To Hold all and singular the above named Premises unto the said Lewis Tackett his heirs & assigns And do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators To Warrant and forever defend the same from every Person or Persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any Part thereof - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 1<sup>st</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred six, and of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States, the 31<sup>st</sup> - Signed and Delivered in Presence of - John W.
