Beginning at a pine running thence N<sup>o</sup> 40 W<sup>t</sup> to a red oak thence S<sup>o</sup> 50 W<sup>t</sup> 27 ch<sup>s</sup> to a chestnut Stake thence S<sup>o</sup> 40 E<sup>t</sup> to a Spruce(Roberts) corner thence to the Beginning. Containing by estimation one hundred acres be the same more or less including the plantation where on the said McFlure now lies also one other tract on both sides of Mill creek above & near the above described tract. Beginning at a red oak running thence N<sup>o</sup> 17 W<sup>t</sup> 19 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 ft to a Stake thence S<sup>o</sup> 55 W<sup>t</sup> 40 ch<sup>s</sup> to a Stake thence S<sup>o</sup> 18 E<sup>t</sup> 19 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 ft to a Stake thence to the Beginning.
