Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Dewey Hodges all that plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres (be the same more or less) Situated in the District aforesaid lying on the branches of Horse Creek waters of Reedy River, Beginning on a poplar 34 Running thence N^o 40 W^o 10 80. to a Stake 34 thence N^o 45 E^o 11 00. to a Hickory 34 thence N^o 25 E^o 15 00. to a pine 34 thence S^o 86 E^o 44 00. to a Spanish oak 34 Bounding on all the lines above mentioned on Dewey Hodges land thence S^o 30 E^o 6 00. to a Red oak 34 Bounding on Thomas Mullicans land thence S^o 63 W^o 30 50. to a Cherry 34 thence S^o 80 W^o 17 50. to a beach 34 on a branch thence up the meanders of said Branch to the Beginning. Bounding on the last mentioned lines on Thompson Bristo's land. (Being part of a tract of four hundred & forty six acres of land originally granted to the said Thompson Bristo on the 7th day of September 1789. as to the said grant Recorded in grant book 33 3/4 page 150) —

Together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances there unto belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining — To Have and To Hold all & singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Dewey Hodges his heirs and assigns forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the Premises above mentioned unto the said Dewey Hodges his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other Person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof —
