of six hundred Dollars to me paid by John Barnhill of the District & State aforesaid
Have granted bargained sold and Released, and by these Presents Do grant bargain
sell and Release unto the said John Barnhill all that tract or parcel of Land
Lying and being in the State and District aforesaid, and on Bush Creek waters of
Needy River, the same being part of three tracts, or surveys, of Land originally
surveyed for and granted to John Hunt, William Varnell & Jesse Carter, and the
tracts or the several parts of tracts, of land hereby meant to be conveyed contains three
Hundred and eighty six acres and bounded as follows, Beginning on a water course
3x at the mouth of a small branch in the survey granted to the said William
Varnell, thence up the meanders of said branch 37 Chain to a black gum 3x on
standing in said branch thence S. 45. 20 Chain to a post oak 3x on. thence N. 33. 8.
25 Chain to a small black oak 3x, thence S. 80. 6. 13 ch. 50 links to a black oak on
the side of the Road 3x on thence S. 25. 6. 13. ch. 50 links to a black oak 3x thence N. 84.
E. 4 ch. to a road known by the name of Goodwin Road thence down the various
meanders of said Road a S. E. Course 30. chain to where the original line
of said Varnell's survey crosses said road to a black oak 3x n.m. thence with
the said original line S. 15. 6. 35. chain to a Stake 3x thence N. 80. W. 40.
Chain to a road at a post oak corner 3x n.m. thence the various Courses of the
road down to Bush Creek 18. Chain and fifty links. thence up the meander
