 KNOW all men by these presents that I James Wafford of the State of South Carolina Spartanburg District for the consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by William Austin of Greenville district the receipt is hereby acknowledged to be well considered satisfied & paid & for the said sum, hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said William Austin him his heirs Executors administrators or assigns four hundred acres of land more or less it being the southward part of a thousand acre tract granted to the said James Wafford Situate in Greenville district lying on Gildings creek the waters of Enoree river, Begining at a pine on the east line of said tract running S. 70 W. 23 ch. 50. links to Stake then S. 7. chains 25. links to Stake the N. 78 W. 18 ch. 10 links to red oak then S. 5 E. 19. ch. 50. links to maple by a branch then up a small part of said bank to red oak 11 chain then N. 2 W. 25. chain to pine then N. 77 W. 12 ch. 75. links to black oak then including all the southward part of said tract four four hundred acres of land let there be more or less together with all the premises and appurtenances thereto belonging to the only proper use & behoof of him the said William Austin him his heirs Executors adm^rs or assigns forever, and he the said William Austin him his heirs Executors adm^rs or assigns shall & may at all times have hold use occupy possess & enjoy the said plantation or tract of four hundred acres of land as aforesaid without manner of trouble or hindrance of him the said James Wafford him his heirs Executors adm^rs or assigns forever, but not to want the said land from any other claim.
