Know all men by these presents that I John Townsen of Greenville district, for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me paid by Joseph Wood of the district aforesaid - Have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bar- gain sell & release unto the S^r Joseph Wood a tract or parcel of land in the District aforesaid, on the branch of the middle fork of Tygar River, being part of Two surveys one granted the fifth day of March 1790. the other on the seventh day of March 1790, unto Robert Goodgion, containing by computation Two hundred and thirty seven acres, (except 20 acre^s conveyed unto Claiborn Johnson Joining of his land) Beginning at a post oak, thence N. 28 W. 30. to a post oak on the corner of land of Ben^t Huddleston thence N. 55 W. 27. 30. to a white oak, thence N. 28. W. 9 to a black oak, thence N. 50 W. 9 to a chestnut thence S. 50 W. 22. to a chestnut thence S. 26 E. 69. to a Stake, on Clayborn Johnson's line, thence along S^r line to a corner, thence along his line until it meets a marked line that is the line of one hundred acre^s that was conveyed to W^m Wood by Robert Goodgion which S^r line leads to the Beginning corner, Together with all and singular the premises before mentioned (except as is Excepted) unto the S^r Joseph Wood all right members hereditamently appertaining therunto belonging or in any appertaining, To Have & To Hold the same, and I the said John Townsen for myself my Heirs Executors & Administrators do hereby warrant and defend the afores^d premises unto the S^r Joseph Wood his heirs and assigns forever again me, and my heirs, & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 29th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven, & 32nd year of America's Independence Signed sealed & Delivered in presence of
