of the district of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of  
one hundred Dollars paid to me in hand by James Harrison Sen<sup>r</sup> of the State and  
District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released unto the said James Harrison  
Sen<sup>r</sup> of the said State and district all my part or moiety of a certain tract of land lying  
and being in the State and district aforesaid, and on the waters of Saluda River -  
originally granted to him the said Ambrose Blackburn & James Harrison as joint  
tenants and signed by Governor Thomas Pinckney on the fifth day of March one  
Thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, for four hundred and sixty seven acres  
all that part of the said tract of land, Beginning on a black oak old marker  
near Robert Maxwell's line, thence with the original line N. E. 20° 32' chains to a  
black oak corner, thence S. W. 80° 22' chains fifty links to a stake the original corner  
thence S. W. 30° 32' chains fifty to a pine corner, thence S. W. 20° 44' Ch<sup>s</sup> to a dogwood  
corner, thence S. E. 30° 30' chains to a stake corner, thence N. 40° 34' to a stake corner  
thence straight or direct to the Beginning; containing one half of the three of one hundred  
acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular rights, members, heredita-  
ments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or apper-  
taining. To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said James Harrison Sen<sup>r</sup> his heirs & assigns forever. and I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said James Harrison Sen<sup>r</sup> his heirs and assigns, against myself  
& heirs, & in short against every person lawfully claiming the same, or any part thereof
