

And I the said John Archer do further agree with William and John Walton their heirs
 & administrators and assigns that if the said Negroes hereby mortgaged shall prove
 insufficient to satisfy the amount due to them on the bond with Interest therein mentioned
 that the House in which I reside together with my tract of land belonging thereto in the said
 district of Greenville with the rights members and appurtenances shall stand mortgaged
 and I do hereby mortgage the same unto the said William Walton & Company their executors
 administrators and assigns for the better and more perfect securing to them any balance which
 may remain due on the aforesaid bond. And I do hereby acknowledge this additional mortgage
 of Real Estate for the purposes aforesaid to be equally valid and binding upon myself my
 heirs Executors & administrators as if the same had been drawn out in a more formal
 manner, nor will I plead or take advantage either in Law or Equity of this Consent & express
 intention to secure the balance which may eventually remain due to the said William Walton &
 Company but at all times confirm and ratify the same any usage or custom to the contrary
