


containing by estimation one hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less, situate in Greenville District and bounded as follows, Beginning on Robert Duncan's line where the branch intersects it that runs through said Brooks Plantation and with said line to his first oak corner, thence with said Duncan's line to a black oak corner it also being John Summons corner thence with said Brooks line to his corner, pine knot thence with Walter Sammons line to his Spring branch thence down the same as it meanders till intersects with the said branch, that runs through Brooks Plantation thence down the same as it meanders to the beginning, it being part of the tract of land whereon said Brock now lives and conveyed to him by Alexander Camp and Robert Duncan in the Year of our Lord ninety three - Together with all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belong or in any wise incident or appertaining - To have & To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joshua Hawkins, his heirs and assigns forever and as I do hereby bind myself, my heirs Exec^{rs} & adm^{rs} to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joshua Hawkins his heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs or any other Person or Persons whatsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim all or any part thereof Witness my hand & seal this second day of January in the year Eight hundred and six, and the 32^d year of American Independance Signed Sealed and delivered in the Presence of us
