Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Arzulep Henderson of the State afores^d & Greenville District, In consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by James Cox of State and District afores^d Have granted & by these presents do sell and release unto the s^d James for all that parcel of land lying in State and District afores^d bounded as follows, Beginning on a dogwood on the west side of Rocky creek on Nelsons old line thence westward to a corner on a stake thence northward on Nelsons old line to a post oak corner Nelsons old corner thence Eastward on said Nelsons line to a red oak corner, on Rocky creek thence running with the water to the Beginning corner, Including the boundaries of said land containing by estimation one hundred acres more or less, Together with all and singular the appurtenances of the said tract of one hundred acres more or less, and all that appertains to the said land and premises before mentioned to the s^d James Cox his heirs and assigns forever, and I the said Arzulep Henderson doth bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend the above described land and premises to the within named James Cox his heirs and assigns from myself my heirs and assigns, and from all other persons claiming the same
