John Ayres of said State and County aforesaid, in the consideration sum of Thirty
Pounds Sterling money to me paid by s^d John Ayres, and I the s^d Daniel Ayres
Have granted bargained sold, and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the s^d John Ayres all that tract of land containing one hundred
and twenty five acres of Land, more or less, situate lying & being on the South
fork of Brush Creek of Reedy River Beginning at a black gum near the
bank of s^a Creek, on Samuel J. Attons thence N. 70. E. 13 Chains fifty links
to white oak, Hunts Corner, thence N. 45. E. nineteen Chains to black Jack thence
S. 60. E. 26 to a stake near a branch of Brush Creek, thence down the several
meanders of s^a Creek, to its Confluence near black gum marked for a corner
Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and
appurtenances to the s^d premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertain-
ing, To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the s^d John Ayres his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind
myself my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the s^d premises unto the s^d John Ayres his heirs and assigns, against
myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand and seal this 7th day of
Nov^r in the year of our Lord 1800 and in the 24th year of the independence of the
United States of America - Will: Ayres
