Know all men by these presents that Willif<sup>s</sup> Benson of the district of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and twenty five dollars to me paid by John Bates of the district of Greenville aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Bates on tract or lot of land situate lying and being in the district of Greenville aforesaid, on the North fork of Saluda river bounded as follows to wit, Begun ing at the River the South side of the River bounded by William Goodlett south course b bounded East by Baylis Earth line untill it intersects David McCays line, bounded North & Course untill it comes to the branch that runs in below the Mill the next branch to the mill thence down the meanders of the branch to the River, thence down the meander of the River to the Beginning containing one hundred acres of land more or less it being part of a tract of land that was originally granted unto William McElhany on the sixth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and eighty four and Conveyed by him to William Benson Deceas<sup>d</sup>. Toge ther with all and singular the right hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to the same and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Bates his heirs Executors administrators forever And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Bates his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
