The State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that we Abner Underwood & Thomas Green of Greenville District for and in consideration of Two Thousand dollars to us in hand paid by Henry Cannon of Spartanburgh District and State aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Henry Cannon the two tracts of land herein after named being part of different tracts originally granted to John Thomas Jun^r Viz, three hundred and ~~more~~ ^{more} known by the name of Mulford, including the plantation whereon the said Thomas Green now lives. Together with the great Saw Mills & Cotton Machine the land being part of different tracts conveyed by Abner Underwood & Thomas Green to the said Henry Cannon, also two hundred and twenty two acres part of a survey of one thousand acres granted to John Thomas Jr and by Abner Underwood & Tho^s Green conveyed to Henry Cannon. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Henry Cannon aforesaid his heirs and assigns forever, & we do firmly bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Cannon his heirs and assigns against us and our heirs and against every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof -
