This Indenture made the tenth day of March one Thousand Eight hundred and Eight between William Anderson and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and William Grant of the state of South Carolina Greenville District of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to me the said Anderson in hand paid by the said Grant and the Right whereof is hereby fully acknowledged and the said Anderson fully satisfied for the same, I have Bargained sold aliened and confirmed unto the said William Grant a plantation or tract of Land by Estimation Two Hundred Acres more or less it being the lower half of a Four Hundred acre Tract of Land Granted unto Archibald Dick by a Grant bearing date the first day of January one Thousand Eight hundred and Eighty five and by the said Dick conveyed unto John Ruple Deceased and by Edward Russell and silver Russell wife of said John Ruple conveyed to John Stanford and from said Stanford to Orenton Goodman and from said Goodman to William Anderson & is bounded as follows Beginning an area oak corner on Henry ¹¹⁵ acres Line running N. 30. W. 55 chains to area oak thence N. 60 E.
