Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert Paden his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Robert Paden his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
