Arnolds land thence S. 50 W. 45. to a stake st. bounding on the said Arnolds land thence S. 40 E. to the Beginning, bounding on James Lovelace's land, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appertenuances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Benj^r. Arnold his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Benj^r. Arnold his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs, and against all other persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
