 Red cow marked with an under bit and over bit & crop from both ears two feather beds
 and furniture Together with all my household furniture, to have and to hold
 the said bargained property unto the said Aerial & Osburn their Executors Administrators
 and assigns forever, and I the said John Tate for myself my Executors Administrators
 shall and will warrant and forever defend against all Persons by these presents the said
 bargained property unto the S^r Aerial & Osburn their Executors Administrators and assigns
 Provided Nevertheless that if I the said John Tate my Executors Administrators
 and assigns or any of us do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto
 the said Aerial & Osburn their Executors Administrators or assigns the sum of Twenty
 three Dollars fifty Cents on the first day of June next insuring the date hereof
 with lawfull interest for the same for redemption of said bargained property then
 the present bill of sale to be void or else to remain in full force, In Witness
