This Indenture made this sixth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eight, between Beverly Borum of the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part, and Ansel Reynolds of the same District and State of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Ansel Reynolds for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to him in hand paid have mortgaged unto the said Beverly Borum his heirs and assigns the following property, viz. One Tract of land containing One hundred acres more or less - bounded by lands of John Browns, Henry Chambers, Abrahm Henry &c - Which said land the said Reynolds mortgages unto the said Borum in virtue of having had and received of the said Borum the said sum of Fifty dollars, the said Reynolds having the Equity of redemption that is to say, paying and discharging the said sum of Fifty dollars on or before the 25 of December 1809. Then this instrument and agreement to be void otherwise the foreclosure of this Mortgage to be carried into effect. This Indenture made this fourteenth day of December and in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eight between - Beverly Borroum of the District of Greenville and State of South Carolina of the one part and John Dacus Jun^r of the same District and State of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Dacus Jun^r for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to him in hand paid have mortgaged unto the said Beverly Borroum his heirs or assigns the following property (viz) one tract of land containing Eighty acres more or less bounded by lands of Wm Bramblet James Wafford & said Borroum also one barrel more two barrels and Eight head of hogs, also two bears and furniture also two pots & one Dutch Oven corn & fodder &c. Which said property the said Dacus mortgages unto the said Borroum in virtue of having had and received of the said Borroum the said sum of fifty dollars the said Dacus having the Equity of Redemption that is to say paying and discharging the said sum of fifty dollars on or before the 25th day of December 1809.
