of South Carolina on the waters of Golden Grove creek joining lands of the
Hon^{ble} Henry Puddleton & lands of John Bowie, and hath such shape
and marks as the plat thereunto belonging Specifies. Together
with all and singular the improvements rights hereditaments and
appurtenances Profits & Advantages. To have and To hold all and singular the
above mentioned premises unto the said John Westfield his heirs and
assigns forever, and I the said William West my heirs Executors & administrators
unto the said John Westfield his heirs Executors & administrators do hereby
warrant and forever defend all and singular the above mentioned tract of
