tion of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the Joshua
Gosnell Witnesseth that the said George Acridge. Hath granted bargained sold
Released, and delivered, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release
and deliver, unto the s^d Joshua Gosnell a certain tract or parcel of land situate
lying and being in the State and district afores^d and on the head of the middle
fork of Sugar River, and branches of Bartons Creek joining land Samuel
Leitry & William Wood, Beginning on a locust and running N. 55. E. 51 to a locust
thence S 38. E. 8 chains to a hickory thence S 26. chains hickory thence S 66. E. 46 to a
pine, thence N. 82. E. 22 to a Spanish oak thence bend on Geantrey's line running
S. 50 to a stake on Woods line thence S 82 W. 22 to a stake binding on Woods
line N. 82. 66. to a stake on John Brasels line bending on s^d line running N. 68
W. 24 to the beginning; containing three hundred acres more or less. With all and
Singular the rights and premises to same belonging. To have and To hold unto
The said Joshua Gosnell his heirs and assigns forever, and s^d George Acridge
doth hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warr ant and forever
defend all and singular the rights and premises unto the said Joshua Gosnell
his heirs and assigns from myself my heirs and assigns and from all and every
Person or Persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof
