I have granted bargained & Sold unto the said Page Rock a certain tract or parcel of land containing Fifty four acres more or less situate in the State and District aforesaid on both sides of Maple creek of Enoree River, Beginning on a hickory corner on the N^o side of said Creek and runs N^o 58. W. 17. Ch^o to a dogwood 34 then N. 25 E. on a direct line between James Tate and said Rock 40 ch^o to a red oak 34 then S. 55 E. 17 ch^o to a hickory 34 then S. 25. W. 40 ch^o to the Beginning which includes Fifty four acres. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. Thereunto and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Ex^{rs} adm^{rs} to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described land & Premises unto the said Page Rock heirs Ex^{rs} adm^{rs} and assigns forever, against myself my heirs Ex^{rs} adm^{rs} and all other Persons that shall lawfully claim any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this thirtieth day of January and in the thirty third year of the independence of the United States of America - Given Harris
