I have bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas Springfield all that tract or parcel of land supposed to be two hundred acres more or less lying on the North side Beaverdam. Beginning at the mouth of D^r Kelly's Spring branch thence up the beaverdam to Springfield line thence along d^r line to Christopher's line to Sammons line thence along said line to the post oak corner joining Lewis Land & D^r Kelly line thence along a conditional line to a post oak across the Road to the head of Kelly's Branch thence along said branch to the Beginning together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises belonging. To Have & To Hold the s^r premises unto the said Springfield his heirs Executors or any of them to warrant and forever defend all the said Premises unto s^r Springfield his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs & every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof. Know all men by these presents that I Ethan Wells of the State and district aforesd for ~~and~~ consideration of the sum of one hundred and ten dollars to me in hand paid by James McDaniel of the same place have granted bargain and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and see unto the said Mr. Daniel a tract or plantation of Land containing severly five acres more or less in the District and State aforesd on a branch of Ruby River the south side of the same, bounding and beginning on the Spring branch thence running along the original line NW to a original post oak corner there S^W 50.25 to a stake there SE to a conditional post Oak corner there may east along a conditional line to a first conditional corner thence along a conditional line to the head of the Spring branch thence down the stream the water to be the line to the beginning corner being a part of a tract of Land Originally granted to Valentine Harlow and assign by His Excellency Charles Pinckney on three day of Decr 1792 as by a plat annexed to the s^r grant
