

To have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin Land his heirs Exec^tg adms^t and the s^r John Kitchens doth bind himself his heirs Executors & adm^ts to forever warrant and defend the above described premises unto the said Benjamin Land his heirs and assigns forever, against himself his heirs Executors & adm^ts and against every other Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully Claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal this seventh day of Nov^r in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and three, and in the twenty eighth year of the independence of the United States of America

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 This Indenture made this thirteenth day of December in the yr. of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety seven, and in the twenty third year of American Independence between Silas Brock of the State of N^c Carolina and County of Lincoln of the one part, and John Kitchen of the State of South Carolina & County of Greenville of the other part. Whereas in and by a certain grant bearing date the first day of April A.D. One thousand seven hundred and ninety three, under the hands of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r Governor of S^e State having the great seal of the State annexed thereto did give and grant unto the said Silas Brock a tract of two hundred and thirty eight acres of land in the County aforesaid, laying on both sides of long branch of Rocky Creek of Grace River, bounded by line running N.E. S.E. S.W. & N.W. by Benj^r Kilgore junior, N.W. by John McHaffys, N.E. by David Lavers the other sides vacant, having such form marks buttin^s & boundings as appears by a plat to the S^r grant annexed, which plat and grant being duly recorded in the secretarie office of S^e State aforesaid thereunto has makes it fully appear, Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said Silas Brock for and in consideration of the sum of sixty pounds current money of the said State to him in hand paid by the said John Kitchen before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, grants, bargains, sells, alienes, conveys, & confirms, and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the said John Kitchen S^r tract of two hundred and thirty eight acres of land, Together with all wood, water, water course
