West 40 to a post oak thence S 62 E. 50 to a red oak thence N. 28 E. 40 to a dogwood thence N. 62 W. 50 to the Beginning, Containing two hundred Acres be the same more or less also one other tract or parcel of land adjoining the above Beginning on a red oak running thence N. 68 p.
