and four. Know all men by these presents that I John Ellidge of the State of North  
Carolina Buncombe County am held and firmly bound unto Stephen Morgan of the  
State of South Carolina Greenville District for and in consideration of the sum of  
Two hundred Dollars paid me, I have granted bargained sold and released and  
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the s<sup>d</sup>. Stephen Morgan  
a part of a tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in Greenville District bounding  
on the South side of the middle fork of Fall Creek of Saluda River, buting &  
bounding on the Rich Mountain, Beginning at said fall creek running South W.  
to a Stake from thence South E, near to a Stake joining Lacyfords line, then running  
on the steep part of the mountain, between Morgans field and fairs from thence to fairs  
line from thence to the Beginning corner, containing two hundred acres be the same  
more or less, being granted for John Ellidge by a patent bearing date the second day  
of December one thousand Seven hundred and ninety three, Together with all singular  
the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging  
or in any wise appertaining. To Have & To Hold all and singular the premises  
before mentioned unto the said Stephen Morgan his heirs and assigns forever  
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises from any Person or Persons  
alleging any Lawful claim or right to the above mentioned premises —

Proven the thirteenth day of October in the year of our Lord 1806.
