twenty fourth year of the Independance of the United States of America between
William Stringer of the one part, and William Morgan of the other
of the State and District aforesaid, Witnesseth that said Stringer doth hereby
acknowledge that he hath bargained sold release conveyed confirmed, By
these presents, Doth bargain and sell release convey and confirm unto the said
William Morgan his heirs and assigns, all that Parcel or tract of Land contain-
ing Three Hundred and Thirty Three acres situated lying on Fall branch
of North fork Saluda River, it being a tract of land containing Three Hundred
and Thirty Three acres is butting and bounding on John Tords land on Baylis Earles,
land and on all other sides unknown or vacant on Baylis Earle land on a black
oak north forty chains to a stake West seventy chains to a stake South forty chains, to
South East thirty four chains and Sixty links Hickory North by East forty chains to a
black oak, WITH every of the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging
it being now in his actual possession his heirs and assigns forever, and the said William
Morgan his heirs and assigns shall & may from time to time hereafter and at all times
Have hold occupy Possess & Enjoy said plantation or tract of land containing Three
Hundred and thirty three acres without any manner of trouble hindrance
molestation interruption or denial of them the said William Stringer his heirs
administrators or assigns or any Persons or Persons whatsoever, And Lastly that
the said William Stringer his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever shall
warrant and defend said tract or parcel of land to William Morgan his heirs Executors
administrators and assigns forever from all or every other Person or Persons by these
