Beginning at the lower corner of Thomas Mottlow's plantation or tract of land originally grant to James Mottlow to said Mottlow running S: 82 W: to a red oak corner thence S: 82 W: to a red oak station thence S: 62 links to a stake
 Mottlow thence S: 83 W: to a dogwood station thence 35 chains 50 links to a corner thence N: 10 W: to a post oak station thence 35 chain to a corner thence N: 83 E: to a poplar station thence 35 chains 50 links to a stake corner thence S: 82 E: 31 chain 62 links to a stake corner on McKechnie's line on Buffs creek thence down said creek to the River thence following the meander of the
