Chandler Henry Mitchell Reuben Fitts William Ship & James Webb did this day appear before me & upon being privately and separately examined by me did declare that they do freely voluntarily and without any compulsion dead or fear of any person or persons whomsoever, Renounce Release and forever Relinquish unto the within named William his heirs and assigns all their Interests and estates, and also all their Rights & Claims of Dower, of in or to all and singular the premises within mentioned and Released, Given under my hand, seal this Eighteenth day of January anno Domini one thousand Eight hundred and Ten. The State of South Carolina. To all whom it may concern I know ye that I Benjamin Arnold of Greenville District & State aforesaid; in consideration of four hundred Dollars to me paid by Prince Negro lad Slave, & Roger his father a man of colour, I have bargain sold Emancipated and free, and by these presents do bargain sell Emancipate & free the said Negro Prince, and I do hereby bind myself & heirs to warrant & forever defend the aforesaid negro in his freedom against myself my heirs & assigns, and against the legal claim of all persons whomsoever. And the said negro Prince is hereby declared free without any let hindrance molestation or interruption of any person or persons whomsoever either in this State or in the United States. Given under my hand & seal this twelfth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred ten, and in the thirty fifth year of the Independence of the United States of America
