

This Indenture made this one thousand Eight hundred
 and Six, between George W. Owen of Greenville district and a State of South
 Carolina, of the one part, and Asa Samford of the district and State aforesaid
 of the other part. Witnesseth that the said George W. Owen doth for and
 in consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty Dollars to him
 in hand well and truly paid by the said Asa Samford the receipt thereof
 is hereby acknowledged by the said George Owen, doth grant bargain sell
 alien Release and Confirm, and by these presents doth grant bargain sell
 alien Release and Confirm unto him the said Asa Samford his heirs and
 assigns forever, all that part of a certain tract of land originally granted
 unto John Lafferty and signed by Governor Pinckney on the sixth day of October
 one thousand seven hundred and Eight lying and being in the aforesaid
 district and on the waters of Reedy River reference therunto will fully appear
 Beginning on the north side of the Quast branch and running on Thomsons
 line to a pine 37 thence on Bonds line to a box oak corner on said bonds line
 from thence along a conditional line to the said Quast branch, from thence
 down the branch to the beginning; containing seventy five acres be the
 same more or less, Together with all and singular the trees ways waters
 hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said
 tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the
 reversion and reversion remainder and remainder if any and profits
 thereof. To Have and To Hold the said parcel or tract of Land and Premises
 hereby bargained and sold with the aid every of the appurtenances unto the
 said Asa Samford his heirs and assigns to his and their only proper use &
 behoof absolutely and forever, and lastly the said George W. Owen for him
 self heirs the said tract of land as above described unto the said Asa Sam-
 ford his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend
 As Witness thereof the said George W. Owen doth here unto set his hand
