 This Indenture made this seventh day of March Eighteen hundred and nine between
 William Griffin of Greenville District of the one part & Young Griffin of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Wm Griffin for the sum of Two hundred Dollars in hand
 paid by said young Griffin the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge
 & by these presents granted sold & sold by these presents deliver & confirm unto the
 said young Griffin his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land
 situate lying & bounding (as follows) on waters of the Enoree River containing one
 hundred acres more or less, Beginning on a pine on Kellys land thence along said
 line to a pine stake corner thence on said line to a Red oak thence to a post oak
 stake corner thence on his line to a Chestnut corner thence a new line to a
 black jack corner thence a new line to the Beginning; with all houses orchards
 gardens fences woods under woods water & water courses thereto Belonging or
 any wise appertaining thereto, To Have & To Hold the said tract or parcel of land
 & all the before mentioned premises unto the said Young Griffin & his heirs forever
 to warrant and defend the said tract of land & premises unto the said Young Griffin
 his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof the said Wm Griffin hath set his hand & seal the day
 & year above written Signed sealed and Delivered in presence of us
